Hyde Park, On October 29th at 6 pm at the 2nd Congregational Church in Hyde Park, local community organizations, Lamoille Neighbors and Lanpher Memorial Library will welcome Vermont Public Radio's Bob Kinzel to discuss the current issues affecting Vermont seniors. Bob Kinzel is a veteran Vermont journalist, specializing in political reporting. He is based in VPR's Capital Bureau located across the street from Vermont's Statehouse. Prior to joining VPR full time in 2002, Bob ran the Vermont News Service for 21 years. The service provided daily local news for eleven stations, including VPR. Bob started the News Service following a stint as news director for WNCS.

Bob Kinzel has had a long career reporting on a wide variety of issues impacting Vermonters, including local and national politics, transportation, child care, and education. His career in journalism gives him a unique vantage point. He will bring this experience and knowledge to the stage to discuss among other topics: safety, housing, social & educational opportunities for seniors.


Volunteer Appreciation Event November 8th, 6PM


